- Commitment to reduce refinery emissions through rule development






Staff identified areas for the Air District, CARB, and steering committee to work together on:

Oil Drilling and Production	 Regularly conducted inspections Working to identify improvements to Rule 1148.2 Working with Community Steering Committee to prioritize oil well sites for monitoring
