

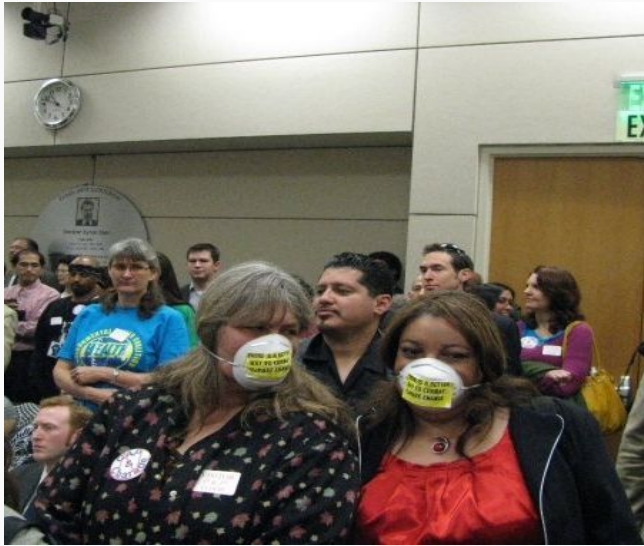

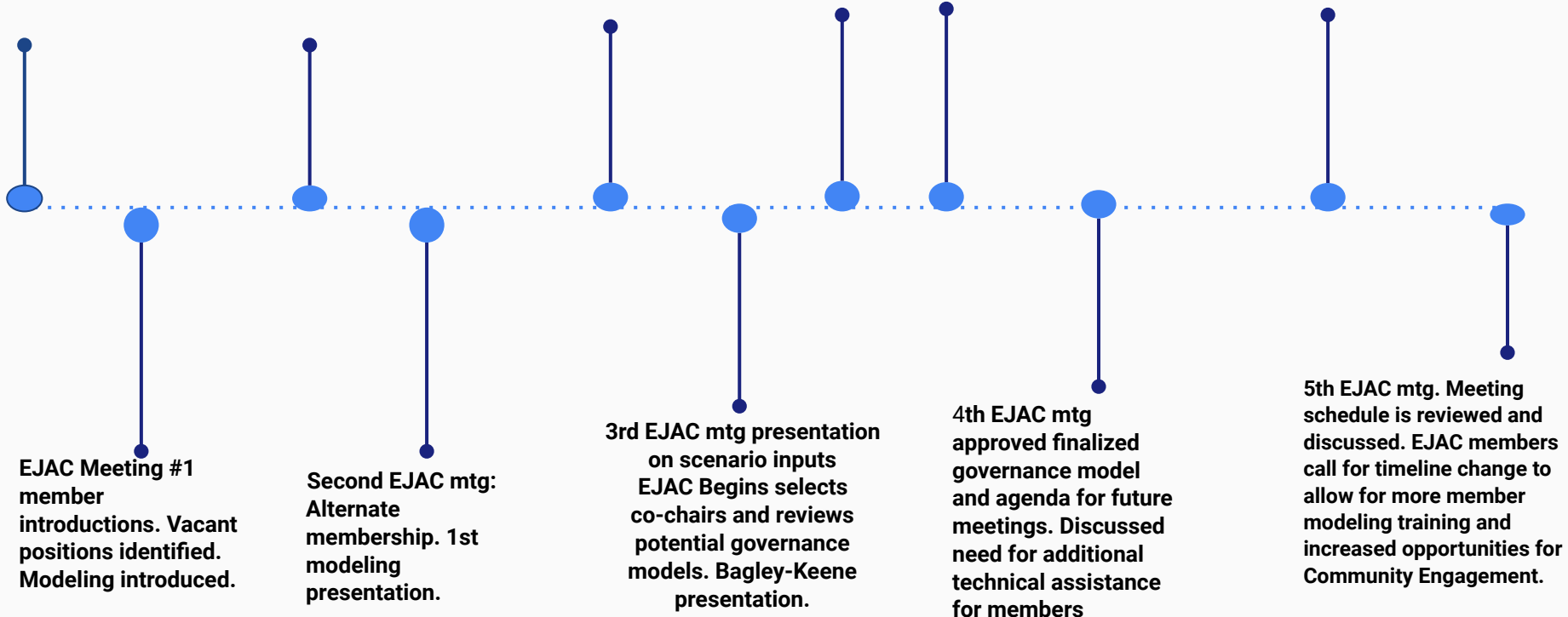


EJAC and Scoping Plan Update: What's transpired thus far.

Proposed EJAC Tasks

EJAC's Proposed Timeline

7/1-8/31/2022: EJAC meets to review and discuss draft scenarios.

11/2022: EJAC review of proposed final draft.

1/19 or 1/26/2023: CARB approves draft scoping plan.

4/2023: EJAC reviews final plan prior to 45 day posting and Board meeting.

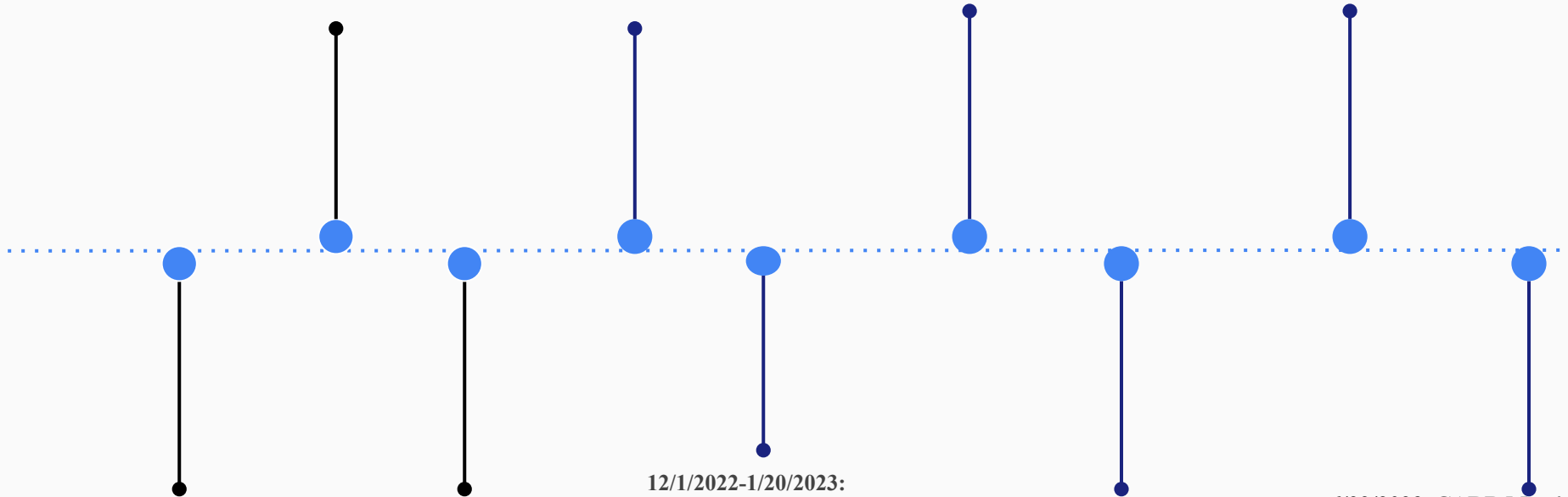
3/1-6/30/2022: EJAC meets monthly with modeling team. Begin work on potential timelines and strategies for implementing different solutions.

12/1/2022-1/20/2023: EJAC conducts public outreach meetings to share draft scoping plan with residents and EJ stakeholders.

2/1-3/30/23: EJAC technical writing team assembles community feedback and public comments for final Board meeting.

6/22/2023: CARB Meeting to approve Scoping Plan Update.

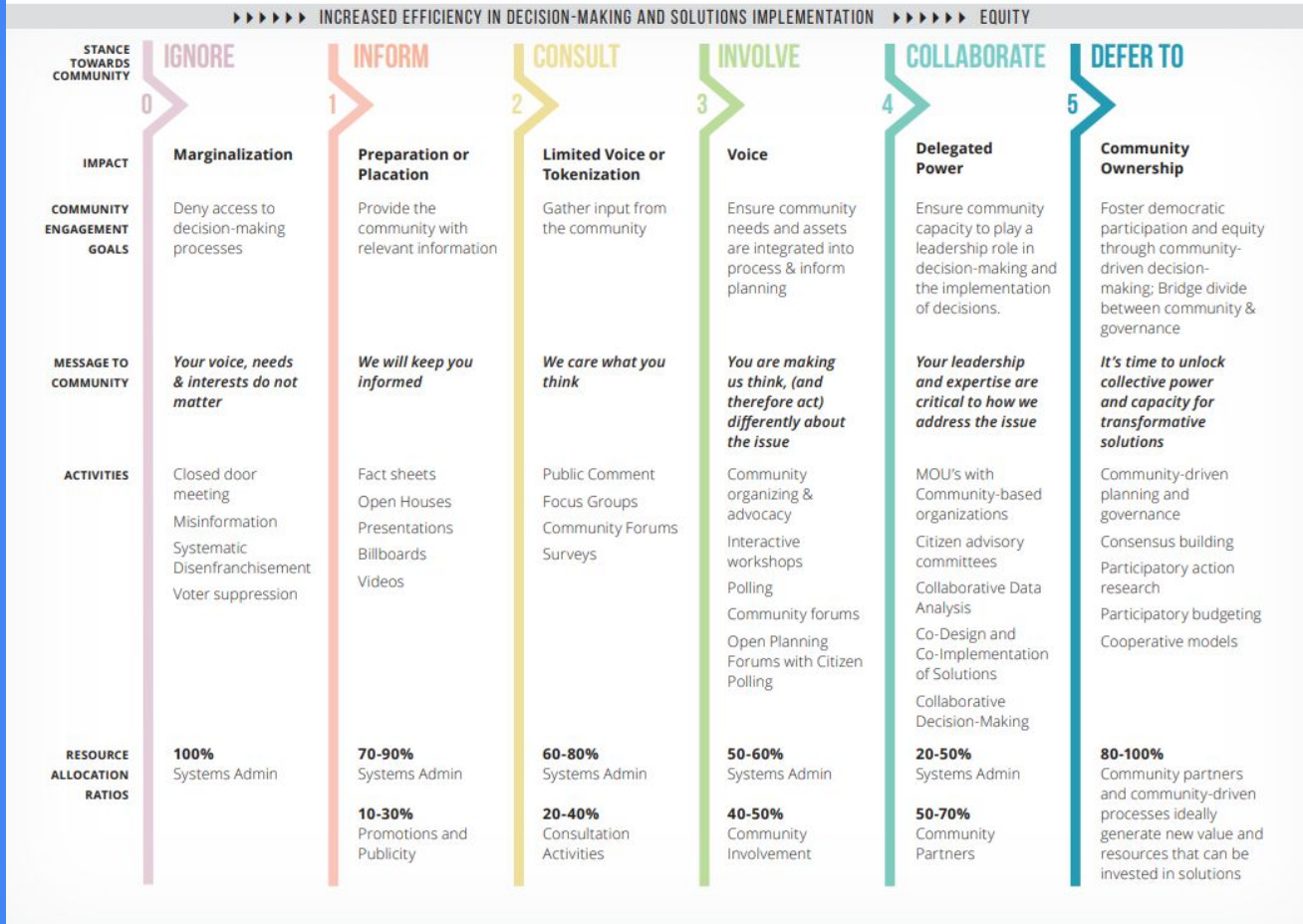

Participation from Inception to Evaluation

Co-Design Process

- **Make the EJAC permanent**
- **Work with EJAC work groups and CARB leads to develop workshop materials and ensure that EJ concerns are infused throughout the workshop**
- **Use Building Decarb Listening Sessions as a potential model**

Opportunities for Collaboration

- Joint EJAC and Public Health Workshop for Scoping Plan
- Joint EJAC and CARB Board meetings
- Independent Technical Assistance to be provided to EJAC

Evaluating Cap-and-Trade

- Revisit cap-and-trade policy and previous Scoping Plans' benefits and burdens.
- How well are *current climate policies* working, and what are the *impacts on EJ communities*?
