SUBJECT: PUBLIC WORKSHOP ON CLIMATE CHANGE EMISSION REDUCTION REGULATIONS

The Air Resources Board (ARB) staff will conduct a public workshop on July 7, 2004, to obtain public comment on a draft staff report on climate change emission reduction regulations. This workshop is intended to provide the public with an early opportunity to review and comment on the proposed staff approach, its rationale, and the staff assessment of its environmental and economic consequences.
