RULE 27 - SUSPENSION OF PERMITS

(Adopted 5/23/77, Revised 3/9/76)

- A. If the holder of any permits provided by the Rules and Regulations of the Ventura County Air Pollution Control District willfully falsifies or within a reasonable time refuses to furnish information, analyses, plans, or specifications requested by the Air Pollution Control District, the Air Pollution Control District may suspend the permit. Notice in writing shall be served on the permittee informing him of such suspension and reasons therefore.
- B. The Air Pollution Control District shall reinstate a suspended permit when all information, analyses, plans, and specifications or other items as called for in the written notice of suspension are furnished, to the satisfaction of the District, or when, in the opinion of the District, good reasons exist therefore.
- C. Every permittee who willfully fails or neglects to furnish information, analyses, plans or specifications required by the Air Pollution Control District is guilty of a misdemeanor.
