

VENTURA COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT

RULE 47 - SOURCE TEST, EMISSION MONITOR, AND CALL-BACK FEES

(Adopted 6/22/99)

Whenever any rule or regulation of the District or the Air Pollution Control Officer requires a source test or an emission monitor inspection, the source owner or operator shall pay the fees specified in this rule no later than 60 days after receiving written notification of the amount of the fee.

A. Gasoline Dispensing Source Test

- 1. First test observed\$210
- 2. Each additional test included in the same appointment.....\$150

B. Source Tests (other than gasoline dispensing)

- 1. Review test protocol and test report\$252
- 2. Source test observation: The fee for on-site observation of testing shall be the greater of either \$378, or an hourly fee based on the actual hours spent by District staff observing the test and traveling to and from the test site. The hourly fee shall be assessed at the hourly service rate for an Air Quality Engineer as approved by the Ventura County Air Pollution Control Board, times 1.3.

C. Emission Monitor Inspection

Fees for the inspection or other evaluation of monitoring devices shall be assessed based on the actual hours spent by District staff conducting such tasks, plus any time spent traveling to and from the location of the monitors. The hourly fee shall be assessed at the hourly service rate for an Air Quality Engineer as approved by the Ventura County Air Pollution Control Board, times 1.3.

D. Call-back

Each stationary source for which an appointment is kept by District staff for a gasoline dispensing source test, a source test, an emission monitor inspection, or a pre-permit inspection, and the test or inspection can not be performed due to conditions beyond the control of District staff, shall be assessed a call-back fee of \$115.00 for each visit which does not result in a test or inspection.
