

VENTURA COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT

RULE 80 – PERMITS

(Adopted 10/22/68, 5/23/72, 10/30/79)

After the date of adoption of this Regulation, no person shall construct, place, maintain, alter, use or operate in excess of five (5) orchard heaters in any place where they may be used or operated for frost protection, without first obtaining a Permit to do so from the Agricultural Commissioner. Application for such Permits shall be made to the Agricultural Commissioner on available forms and shall contain all information required by such forms. The Agricultural Commissioner may require the applicant to furnish such additional information as he may deem necessary before acting on any application.

Information on Permits may be brought up to date through the use of questionnaires mailed out by the Agricultural Commissioner. This questionnaire will be mailed to the mailing address on the original application and permit. If a grower fails to answer the questionnaire, the Permit may be cancelled and a new Permit application and filing fee may be required by the Agricultural Commissioner. A Permit shall remain valid if questionnaires have been filed satisfactorily and provisions of this Regulation have been complied with.
