**100 GENERAL**

101 **PURPOSE:** The purpose of this rule is to provide for the issuance of Acid Rain Permits as required under the provisions of Title IV of the Federal Clean Air Act by incorporating those provisions, as promulgated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA), at 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Parts 72 through 78, into this rule by reference.

102 **APPLICABILITY:** The provisions of this rule are applicable to an affected source, as defined in 40 CFR Part 72.

**200 DEFINITIONS:** Except as defined below, the terms used in this Rule are the same as defined in 40 CFR Parts 72 and 76.

201 **ADMINISTRATOR:** For the purposes of this rule the term “Administrator” means the Administrator of the US EPA.

202 **PERMITTING AUTHORITY:** For the purposes of this rule the words “permitting authority” mean the Air Pollution Control Officer or designee of the Yolo-Solano Air Quality Management District.

**300 STANDARDS**
