Thank you for utilizing the California Air Resources Board's (CARB) online reporting system, DOORS, for the "Regulation for In-Use Off-Road Diesel-Fueled Fleets" (Off-Road Regulation) and Large Spark Ignition Engine Fleet Regulation (LSI Regulation). CARB is sending this courtesy notification after reviewing your fleet information and finding that you have created a fleet that currently contains zero pieces of equipment in DOORS.

2. Review the empty fleet and decide if it is a duplicate or it is no longer in operation.
3. Reply to this email with a request for staff to delete this fleet. Include in the email the following information:
 - a. The DOORS ID.
 - b. The reason for deleting the fleet: Either it is a duplicate or the fleet is no longer in operation
