**Subject: Off-Road Diesel Vehicle Regulation/Ground Support Equipment (GSE)**

Dear Fleet Contact,

Thank you for reporting your off-road diesel vehicles in the Diesel Off-Road Online Reporting System (DOORS) for the Off-Road Diesel Vehicle Regulation. You are receiving this email because we noticed that you have reported vehicles as Ground Support Equipment (GSE), but your fleet does not appear to be within the airline/air freight industry. GSE, or airport GSE, are defined as vehicles used to service and support aircraft operations. Airport GSE typically include such vehicle types as baggage tugs, belt loaders, and aircraft tractors.

We are requesting that you please update the following vehicles in fleet #**0000** to reflect the appropriate vehicle type:

Reporting your equipment type accurately in DOORS is important for compliance with the Off-Road Diesel Vehicle Regulation. Additionally, diesel GSE vehicles are treated differently in terms of credit when they are replaced with electric GSE vehicles.
