Subject: Diesel Off-Road Online Reporting System (DOORS) – On/Off-Road Engine Field

Dear Fleet Contact,

Thank you for reporting your off-road fleet in the Diesel Off-road Online Reporting System (DOORS). ARB staff have identified that you have reported one or more vehicles with on-road engines using the “On/Off-Road Engine” field in DOORS, but did not categorize the engines as “On-Road” under “Certified to a Different Standard”. Since on-road engines are typically cleaner than off-road engines of the same model year and horsepower category, fleets can claim a lower emission standard by reporting the engine(s) as certified to a different standard and providing additional information.

In order to get the proper emissions benefit for your on-road engine(s), you must report the engine as “On-Road” under “Certified to a Different Standard” on the “Vehicle & Engine” page in DOORS. Then, on the “Non-Standard Engine” page, enter the Executive Order (EO) number for the engine certification. EO numbers for on-road engines can be found on the certification program page at <http://www.arb.ca.gov/msprog/onroad/cert/cert.php>.

However, if you have determined that your vehicle does not contain an on-road engine, please let us know and we can remove the “On-Road” designation from your vehicle.
