Dear Fleet Contact,

Thank you for reporting your off-road diesel vehicles in the Diesel Off-Road Online Reporting System (DOORS) for the Off-Road Diesel Vehicle Regulation. You are receiving this email because we noticed that you are a State or federal fleet but have not yet indicated the appropriate Parent ID number for your DOORS account. Federal and State government-owned fleets are considered large fleets, regardless of fleet size, and should report with a Parent DOORS ID of 9 or 10, respectively. ARB staff will add the appropriate Parent DOORS ID to your Owner Information page in your DOORS account. Please be aware that State and federal fleets, along with all other large fleets, have annual reporting requirements that began on March 1st of this year and will continue each year through 2023. Your fleet is also required to meet performance requirements (fleet average target rate or Best Available Control Technology requirements) by January 1, 2014, and each year thereafter, through at least 2023.
