The Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) hereby submits to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) amendments to the State Strategy for California's 2007 State Implementation Plan (SIP). The amendments reflect the Proposed SIP Commitment for the San Joaquin Valley adopted by the Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) on April 17, 2009.
