## APPROVAL OF THE EIGHT-HOUR OZONE ATTAINMENT PLAN FOR SAN DIEGO COUNTY

On May 23, 2007, the San Diego County Air Pollution Control Board considered and approved the Eight-Hour Ozone Attainment Plan for San Diego County. The Board also adopted a Negative Declaration pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act. The Board directed that the Eight-Hour Ozone Attainment Plan for San Diego County and supporting documentation be forwarded to the California Air Resources Board (ARB) for expeditious submittal to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
