The Air Resources Board (ARB) is transmitting to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) the 2007 PM10 Maintenance Plan and Request for Redesignation (Plan) for the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District (District). The District adopted the Plan on September 20, 2007, and transmitted it to ARB on September 21, 2007. ARB approved the Plan on October 25, 2007, as a revision to the California State Implementation Plan (SIP).

The Plan includes updated transportation conformity budgets. ARB requests that U.S. EPA conduct its technical evaluation to find the budgets adequate in an accelerated mode, and complete the determination by January 2008, to avoid delay in transportation projects.
