**Notice of Decision**

**Project Title:** Evaporative Emission Control Requirements for Off-Highway  
Recreational Vehicles

(SCH# 2013062007)

**Project Location:** Statewide

**Public Meeting Date:** July 25, 2013; Agenda Item 13-7-3

**Project Description:** The purpose of the regulation is to control evaporative emissions from off-highway recreational vehicles (OHRVs). The regulation controls evaporative emissions from OHRVs by:

- (1) applying evaporative emission standards;
- (2) including provisions for certification, labeling, enforcement, recall, and use restrictions;
- (3) implementing a new test procedure to measure evaporative emissions; and
- (4) establishing durability requirements for evaporative emission system components.

This notice is to advise that ARB, as the lead agency, has adopted the above described regulatory action on June 6, 2014 and has determined that the regulatory action will not have a significant adverse effect on the environment (see attached Executive Order #R-14-002).

ARB prepared an environmental analysis (EA) in accordance with the requirements of its certified regulatory program under CEQA. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, §15251, sub. (d).) The EA, included in the *Staff Report: Initial Statement of Reasons for the Adoption of Evaporative Emission Control Requirements for Off-Highway Recreational Vehicles* (Staff Report) prepared for the proposed rulemaking, concluded implementation of the amendments would not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts. During the 45-day comment period, no comments received raised any significant environmental issues pertaining to this item.

No mitigation measures, findings, or statement of overriding considerations were adopted for this regulatory action because the regulation will not result in any significant adverse impacts on the environment.
