NOTICE OF POSTPONEMENT

PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE REGULATION ON THE COMMERCIALIZATION OF ALTERNATIVE DIESEL FUELS

By notice dated December 24, 2019, and published in the January 10, 2020, California Regulatory Notice Register, Register 2020 No. 2-Z, the California Air Resources Board (CARB or Board) announced it would conduct a public hearing to consider approving for adoption the proposed amendments to the Regulation on the Commercialization of Alternative Diesel Fuels (ADF). The hearing was scheduled for March 26, 2020, at 9:00 a.m., at the California Environmental Protection Agency, California Air Resources Board, 1001 "I" Street, Byron Sher Auditorium, Second Floor, Sacramento, California.

PLEASE BE ADVISED that, consistent with the recommendations from the California Department of Public Health to postpone or cancel large community events in order to slow the spread of COVID-19, CARB will not hold the March 26, 2020, Board Meeting. The hearing on this regulatory action has thus been postponed to a future date and time. A subsequent notice will follow in the near future with more information, including the date, time, and location of any rescheduled hearing. The public comment period for this regulatory action, which began on January 10, 2020 and ended on February 24, 2020, will not be extended.
