State of California AIR RESOURCES BOARD

Executive Order G-01-003

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2000, the Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) conducted a public hearing to consider amendments to the Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Fee Regulation for Fiscal Year 2000-2001, as set forth in the Staff Report: Initial Statement of Reasons released to the public on September 8, 2000;

WHEREAS, following the public hearing on October 26, 2000, the Board adopted Resolution 00-36, in which the Board approved amendments to Tables 1, 2, 3a, 3c and 4, in section 90705, as determined by sections 90701-90705, title 17, California Code of Regulations, as set forth in Attachments A and B thereto;

WHEREAS, the Board in Resolution 00-36 directed the Executive Officer to adopt the regulations, and the modifications as described in Attachment B thereto, after making the modified regulatory language available for public comment for a period of 15 days; provided that the Executive Officer shall consider such written comments as were submitted during this period, make such modifications as were appropriate in light of the comments received, and to present the regulations to the Board for further consideration if he determined that this was warranted;

WHEREAS, the approved regulations, with modifications to the originally proposed text clearly indicated, have been made available for a public comment period of 15 days in accordance with the provisions of title 1, California Code of Regulations, section 44;

WHEREAS, no written comments were received during the 15-day public comment period;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 00-36 are incorporated by reference herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, in accordance with Resolution 00-36, that Tables 1, 2, 3a, 3b, 3c and 4, in section 90705, title 17, California Code of Regulations, are hereby adopted as set forth in Attachment 1 to this Order.
