Pursuant to your findings in the above mentioned rulemaking the ARB hereby authorizes you to make the following corrections:

1. Substitute the Final Regulation Order (eight copies provided) and the two documents incorporated by reference (International Standard ISO 8217:2005(E) and International Standard ISO 8754:2003(E)) behind each copy of the Form 400 and behind the Executive Order in Tab 2.
2. Behind Tab 12 add the attached four form letters that were inadvertently left out of record.
3. Behind Tab 15 add the attached seven comment letters that were inadvertently left out of record.
4. Correct the Form 400 section B5, check box "Effective on Filing with Secretary of State"
5. Substitute the attached revised "Certification" for closing the rulemaking record in place of that which was originally submitted, to reflect reopening of the rulemaking record to include changes to the above-mentioned documents, before the TOC in front of Tab 1.

With regard to Item 2 above, the four form letters (shown as #1, 2, 3, and 4) represent the over 1600 supportive comment letters noted in the FSOR. Form Letter #1 was representative of approximately 1000 comment letters, Form Letter #2 about 600 letters, Form Letter #3 about 52 letters, and Form Letter #4 about 23 postcards. All of these comment letters provide essentially the same general comments in support of the rulemaking, with only minor variations among them.
