NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING OF THE CALIFORNIA AIR RESOURCES BOARD, THE CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION, AND THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

The California Air Resources Board (CARB or Board) will host a joint public meeting between CARB, the California Transportation Commission (CTC or Commission), and the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) as noted below.

DATE: November 4, 2020

TIME: 9:00 a.m.

This meeting is the second of two annual joint meetings between these agencies to coordinate interagency efforts to implement policies that jointly affect transportation, housing, and air quality. The meeting will focus on aligning the agencies' actions to deepen that work and better achieve the State's climate goals

In accordance with Governor Newsom's Executive Orders [N-29-20](#) and [N-33-20](#) as well as recommendations from the California Department of Public Health, this meeting will not have a physical location. This will be a remote-only meeting that is open to the public, and we encourage your participation. Please see the Public Agenda for direction regarding participation in this meeting; the agenda will be posted ten days before the November 4, 2020, Joint Meeting on CARB's Board Meetings webpage (<https://ww2.arb.ca.gov/our-work/programs/board-meetings>).

This meeting will commence at 9:00 a.m. on November 4, 2020. This meeting of the Board, the Commission, and HCD is separate from the CARB November Board meeting and will not be on the November Board agenda.

Background

In June 2018, CARB and CTC began meeting twice per calendar year to coordinate implementation of transportation programs and policies, pursuant to Assembly Bill (AB) 179 (Cervantes, Chapter 737, Statutes of 2017). In 2019, AB 185 (Grayson, Chapter 534, Statutes of 2019) added a representative from HCD to the joint meetings and expanded the scope of these meetings to include discussions of policies that jointly affect transportation, housing, and air quality.

Joint meetings are more informal than Board or Commission meetings. Presentations will facilitate open dialogue amongst the Board, Commission, HCD, and the public. We encourage public participation, and there will be dedicated time allotted for public comments.

Submittal of Comments

Interested members of the public may present comments orally or in writing at the Joint Meeting and may provide comments by postal mail or by electronic submittal before the meeting. Comments submitted in advance of the joint meeting must be received **no later than November 2, 2020**, and addressed to the following:
