

FINAL REGULATION ORDER

Repeal Title 13, California Code of Regulations, Sections 2201 and 2202, as follows:

~~§2201. General Policy:~~

~~It shall be the policy of the state board to evaluate all ideas, proposals, devices, and fuel additives submitted to the staff of the state board as possible means of reducing vehicular pollution. In the review of such submittals, the state board staff shall provide courteous, prompt, and reasonable evaluation, but at the same time, the staff is not to be subjected to unnecessary diversions that would be caused by the review of proposals which are either clearly incapable of producing solutions to any air pollution problems or have been subject to previous exhaustive test programs:~~

~~§2202. Performance Requirements~~

~~Subject to other provisions of this subchapter, applicable test procedure(s), if any, adopted by the state board, will be used in the evaluation process. The performance of each control device or fuel additive will be evaluated to determine its effectiveness in reducing vehicular emissions and compliance to determine its effectiveness emission standards.~~
