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**I. Proposition 1B: Goods Movement  
Emission Reduction Program**

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## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The \$1 billion Proposition 1B: Goods Movement Emission Reduction Program (Program) is successfully underway in California's four priority trade corridors, reducing freight pollution and the associated health risks in communities near seaports, rail yards, freeways, and distribution centers. Health and Safety Code section 39625 et seq. established the Program and directed the Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) to maximize emission reduction benefits while achieving the earliest possible health risk reductions. This report describes the progress on the Program through September 2013, including a listing of each grant with the funding amount, location, the number of trucks or other equipment that have been or are being upgraded, the timeframe for completion, and the expected emission reductions.

ARB has allocated approximately \$740 million for local agency projects and ARB's administration costs over multiple years. ARB has received almost \$587 million in cash from multiple bonds sales and commercial paper and has been approved for the majority of the cash under the current \$154 million appropriation. ARB will need to request the balance of the cash through the established Department of Finance process. A new appropriation will be needed for the remaining \$240 million, which reverted due to cash not being available. ARB awards and oversees grants to local agencies that in turn offer competitive incentives to diesel equipment owners to upgrade to cleaner technologies ahead of, or beyond, regulatory requirements. To ensure accountability and effectiveness, all grants are awarded in an open, public process required by ARB Program Guidelines.

With nearly \$250 million from the Program's first funding cycle, over 5,000 diesel trucks were replaced or retrofitted by the end of 2011, grid-based electrical power was installed at three ship berths at the Port of Oakland, and 19 locomotives were upgraded and are operating in the Central Valley and Los Angeles/Inland Empire. These first year projects will reduce almost three million pounds of fine particulate matter (PM) plus over 54 million pounds of nitrogen oxides (NOx) in California over the term of the grant contracts.

The funding in the second cycle was received and awarded in two phases. With \$200 million awarded in June 2010 and approximately \$116 million awarded in December 2011, over 5,000 trucks, 34 ship berths and one harbor craft were funded for upgrades completed by December 2013. Six locomotives are expected to be operational in 2014. ARB estimates these projects will reduce about 2 million pounds of PM and over 71 million pounds of NOx over the term of the grant contracts.

For the third cycle of funding, ARB awarded \$150 million; the local agencies held solicitations for truck projects until December 2013 and will be implementing these projects during 2014 with trucks on the road by the end of 2014.

December 2013 Status Report to the Department of Finance

This status report provides an update on implementation of the \$1 billion Proposition 1B: Goods Movement Emission Reduction Program (Program) to reduce emissions and health risk from freight operations in California's priority trade corridors through incentives. Consistent with State law, the Program Guidelines for Implementation (Guidelines) and related documents detail the grant requirements for the Air Resources Board (ARB or Board), participating local agencies, and equipment owners (see Program website at: <http://www.arb.ca.gov/gmbond>).

ARB adopts the Guidelines, and then solicits, awards, funds, and oversees grants to local agencies like air districts and seaports. The local agencies offer grants/contracts in a competitive process to diesel equipment owners to co-fund the upgrade of diesel equipment to cleaner technologies, ahead of or beyond any regulatory requirements to do so. To ensure accountability and effective use of these public funds, the local agencies: solicit for eligible projects, review applications, inspect the old equipment, provide data to competitively rank each piece of equipment based on emission reductions and cost-effectiveness, sign contracts with equipment owners, inspect the upgraded equipment, make payment for the cleaner technology, and track/report on funded projects.

The information in this report is based on the local agencies' semi-annual reports as of September 30, 2013. The tables following the narrative in this report describe the progress of each grant using the funds received from appropriations, including the grant award, the number of trucks or other equipment being upgraded, and estimated emission reductions.

### **Available Funding and Expenditures**

Each budget appropriation authorizes ARB to use a specific amount of funding for this Program, within statutory timeframes. However, the appropriation does not provide any cash for this purpose. Therefore, we depend on the receipt of proceeds from State bond sales or other mechanisms the fund new projects.

The entire \$1 billion has been appropriated in State budgets, with \$980 million to ARB for this Program and \$20 million set aside by the control agencies to cover bond issuance and oversight costs. ARB has allocated approximately \$740 million for local agency projects and ARB's administration costs over multiple years. A new appropriation will be needed for the remaining \$240 million, which reverted due to cash not being available.

ARB has received almost \$587 million in cash from multiple bond sales and commercial paper and has paid out \$577 million to local agencies and for ARB's administration costs through September 2013. ARB has access to commercial paper to close out the existing ships at berth and locomotive projects, provide funds for

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Fiscal Year (FY) 2013-14 projects, and cover administration costs. ARB will need to request the balance of the cash needed through the established Department of Finance process.

### **Current Status and Implementation of FY2013-14 Funds**

On July 25, 2013, the Board awarded approximately \$150 million, of which \$143 million was allocated for truck projects throughout the State, including \$5.3 million for loan assistance. In addition, \$6 million was allocated towards a truck filter substrate replacement program and nearly \$1 million for harbor craft projects. ARB is in the process of executing grant agreements with the local agencies and will make initial payments to the local agencies in early January 2014. ARB will reallocate the \$5.3 million awarded for loan assistance to local agency truck projects for small fleets based on the significant demand for project funds.

Local agencies held solicitations for truck projects beginning August 2013 through early October 2013 and a subsequent backup truck solicitation prioritizing small fleets between early October 2013 and early December 2013 (2013 Truck Solicitations). Local agencies will competitively rank these projects, sign contracts with equipment owners, and complete these projects by the end of 2014.

### **Implementation of FY2008-09 and FY2011-12 Funds**

In June 2010, the Board awarded \$200 million in available cash primarily for truck projects and ships at berth/cargo handling equipment projects, and with smaller grants for locomotive and harbor craft projects.

In December 2011, the Board awarded \$100.8 million from the Fall 2011 bond sale and also allocated potential proceeds from a Spring 2012 bond sale; all of these funds were used for truck projects. Proceeds from the Fall bond sale were used to fund drayage truck projects, loan guarantees, and other truck projects covered under grant agreements. ARB received approximately \$15 million to complete the truck projects from the Spring bond sale. The funds were allocated to local agencies for truck projects in accordance with the December 2011 Board approval. Additionally, \$6 million in ARB administration funds were reallocated to local agencies for truck projects.

**Trucks.** ARB signed grant agreements with six local agencies in the four trade corridors for the Phase 1 truck projects in early 2011, followed by the local agencies holding coordinated statewide solicitations. There was significant demand for Program funds and ARB received additional funds in late 2011, which were used to provide funds for Phase 2 truck projects that were awarded in December 2011. The local agencies will complete the truck projects by the end of 2013.

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Also in December 2011, ARB set aside \$66.6 million for drayage trucks. These funds were reserved for applicants that were in compliance with the first phase of the Drayage Truck Regulation and chose to comply early with the second phase by January 1, 2013. Funds not used for drayage trucks were made available for (non-drayage) truck projects. Local agencies requested that funds not utilized due to project fallout be made available to fund projects from the 2013 Truck Solicitations and ARB has approved these requests.

***Ships at Berth, Locomotives, and Commercial Harbor Craft.*** All the ships at berth projects have completed construction and demonstrated operation with ships plugging into the grid starting in January 2014. Six locomotives operating in the Los Angeles/Inland Empire trade corridor are anticipated to be operational in 2014. In addition, the commercial harbor craft project is now operational and the grant is completed.

### **Implementation of FY2007-08 Funds**

The first year (FY2007-08) funds of approximately \$246 million were used for projects to upgrade trucks, locomotives, and ships at berth. All of these projects were suspended for 6 to 14 months due to the December 2008 “stop work” order on bond funded programs, which resulted in an extended delay from time of application to contract. This led to some funds being unused by the local agencies. ARB and the local agencies amended grant agreements from undersubscribed grants to oversubscribed grants. The truck, ships at berth, and locomotive projects have been completed.

### **Project Results – All Fiscal Year Funds**

The Program bond monies are leveraging substantial match funding from private, local, and federal sources – more than one match dollar for every Program dollar invested.

***Trucks.*** The local agencies completed the truck projects from the FY2007-08 funds by the end of 2011 with more than 5,000 cleaner trucks operating in the four trade corridors. The local agencies are in the process of funding projects under the FY2008-09 and FY2011-12 grants. Over 4,000 trucks are operational and the majority of the remaining trucks are expected to be operational by the end of 2013.

***Ships at Berth, Locomotives, and Commercial Harbor Craft.*** The Bay Area District’s early grant project to install grid-based electrical power for three ship berths at the Port of Oakland was completed in 2011 and the installation of power at nine additional berths was recently completed. The South Coast District is implementing projects to install shore-side power for 25 berths at the Ports of Long Beach, Los Angeles, and Hueneme. All ships at berth projects in Southern California completed construction and preliminary testing in 2013.

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The Sacramento and South Coast Districts have completed the upgrade of 19 locomotives operating in the Central Valley and the Los Angeles/Inland Empire trade corridors. In addition, the San Diego District's harbor craft project in the San Diego/Border trade corridor is operational.

### **Project Benefits**

When implemented, we expect projects included in this report will reduce about 5 million pounds or 2,530 tons of particulate matter (PM), plus over 136 million pounds or 68,280 tons of nitrogen oxides (NOx). Emission reductions for projects funded through 2013 are over the life of their grant term (e.g., 2 to 5 years for trucks and 10 years for ships at berth). Emission reductions for the FY2013-14 grants take into consideration ARB's regulations and include only the portion of the emission reductions that are early or extra to the regulations.

### **Project Status by Grant Agreement**

The tables on the following pages present the current project status of each grant based on information from the September 30, 2013, local agency semi-annual reports for FY2011-12 and earlier projects. Information for the FY2013-14 grants is based on the recently awarded funds.

This report shows the information by trade corridor and within each trade corridor by applicable fiscal year appropriation. We have combined the information for the FY2008-09 and FY2011-12 grants for other truck projects because these grants cover projects from the same statewide solicitation and the same ranked lists, although the funds are from different fiscal year appropriations. Additionally, the information for the FY2013-14 other truck projects include funds reallocated from FY2008-09 or FY2011-12 grants that were not utilized due to project fallout. Truck counts will be updated as local agencies provide the results of their 2013 Truck Solicitations.

Projects are selected for funding on the basis of their competitive ranking, which reflects cost-effectiveness and emission reduction benefits. Since each ranked list may be updated to reflect project fallout or revised information, we preserve the overall ranking hierarchy by maintaining a single project list rather than separating the list by fiscal year within each grant.

**II. Proposition 1B:  
Lower-Emission School Bus Program**

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## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Since 2000, the Lower-Emission School Bus Program (LESBP) has provided over \$300 million for purchasing new, lower-emitting school buses and for retrofitting buses with diesel particulate filters. New school buses and school buses retrofit with filters are important steps in reducing children's exposure to the harmful effects of toxic diesel particulate matter emissions. In the seven years leading up to the passage of Proposition 1B in 2006, the Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) administered State funds totaling just over \$100 million to replace 600 of the oldest, most polluting public school buses and retrofit about 3,800 other diesel school buses with ARB-verified pollution control equipment that significantly reduces toxic particulate matter emissions.

Proposition 1B authorized \$200 million in new incentive funding for ARB to reduce air pollution and the related health risk from diesel-fueled school buses through the already established LESBP. Under the LESBP guidelines, the ARB awards funding to local air districts; in turn, the local air districts then solicit and review applications from school districts and execute, complete and reimburse contracts to replace or retrofit in-use school buses. The Board approved the current version of the LESBP guidelines in March 2008 and has allocated and disbursed over \$194 million to 35 local air districts. The balance of the authorized funding was retained for ARB and Department of Finance administration costs as specified by the implementing statute.

The initial expenditure deadline for LESBP Proposition 1B funding was extended from June 30, 2011, to June 30, 2012, to accommodate bond funding delays and to allow for flexibility given the uncertainty in the timing of full bond funding for the LESBP. Since then, Senate Bill 1018 Chapter 39, Statutes of 2012 (SB 1018) extended the LESBP expenditure deadline from June 30, 2012, to June 30, 2014, to allow time for remaining funds to be spent on cleaning up California's school bus fleet thereby protecting children's health from the harmful effects of air pollution. Unspent LESBP Proposition 1B funds, including accrued interest, that were not committed by an executed contract by June 30, 2012, are subject to transfer to another local air district that demonstrates an ability to fully expend (liquidate) funds by January 1, 2014. Local air districts have until June 30, 2014, to expend all funds.

Assembly Bill 110, Chapter 20, Statutes of 2013 (AB 110) authorizes \$700,000 of Proposition 1B funds, and Senate Bill 96, Chapter 356, Statutes of 2013 (SB 96) directs the use of those funds on the LESBP. These funds must be encumbered by June 30, 2014, and disbursed (liquidated) to the air districts by June 30, 2016.

- As of November 2013, local air districts executed contracts for 1,024 school bus replacements and 3,532 retrofits, obligating about 99 percent of the available Proposition 1B project funds.
